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THRIVE'S HISTORY

The Clubhouse, a Psychosocial Rehabilitation Program for adults with severe and persistent mental illness, started in 1983 as a program of Trend Mental Health Services, Mountain Laurel Community Services, and New Vistas-Mountain Laurel. In 2006, New Vistas-Mountain Laurel dissolved and the Clubhouse almost closed, which would have left a debilitating gap in mental health services in Henderson County. Sixth Avenue Psychiatric Rehabilitation Partners, Inc. (SAPRP) was established. In 2012, SAPRP transitioned to Thrive, moving people from surviving to thriving. In the years since the Clubhouse was established, staff had seen that many members struggled with housing insecurity and financial management. Seeing these issues with many Clubhouse members led the staff to develop two other programs. In 2016, Thrive added Representative Payee Services to assist individuals with Social Security or Disability income obtain financial security. In 2017, Thrive added a third program, Housing Case Management, to help people experiencing homelessness achieve housing stability in 4 counties. Thrive's Housing program uses the Housing-First model so that individuals and families can obtain housing with the fewest number of barriers. We believe that basic

needs must be met first before clients can begin to work on higher-order needs like mental health.

Our mission is to empower individuals with mental health and housing needs to thrive in a supportive community; we help move people from surviving to thriving.

We envision an inclusive and compassionate Western North Carolina free of barriers to stable housing and mental health support opening doors for community members to reach their full potential.

OUR HOUSING PROGRAM

Established in 2017, Thrive's Housing Case Management program utilizes a housing-first approach, prioritizing the connection of individuals and families to permanent housing. We serve individuals from birth to end of life in Henderson, Polk, Rutherford, and Transylvania counties.

Our dedicated Case Managers provide crucial support in various aspects, including assisting clients in finding safe and affordable housing, obtaining necessary documents like birth certificates, covering deposits and move-in fees, and acquiring essential household items. The program extends beyond the initial housing phase, teaching clients how to become successful tenants and connecting them to vital resources in the community.

Thrive's Housing Program helps those who are the HUD definition of homelessness, encompassing individuals living in places not suitable for human habitation, such as tents, cars, or abandoned buildings. By offering holistic Case Management services, we strive to empower clients to achieve and maintain housing stability, preventing the cycle of homelessness.
